Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What kind of anesthesia is used at Central Ohio Urology Surgery Center?

A. We use general anesthesia so you will be completely asleep during the entire surgery. Your anesthesia will be controlled the entire time by an anesthesia doctor and not an assistant or anesthesia nurse. Also, there are no students or other learners at the center.

Q. How do you handle complications during surgery?

A. Our experienced team of surgeons has performed thousands of robotic surgeries and is prepared for any potential complications that could occur during your surgery. Our anesthesiologists provide services at local hospitals and can handle any anesthesia-related issues. In the exceedingly rare event of an unexpected or unusual complication, we can transport you to a local hospital which is only 2.5 miles away, but this occurs much less than 1% of the time.

Q. What if I can't go home the same day as my surgery?

A. Almost all patients will be comfortable going home after robotic surgery because it is minimally invasive and done with only a few small incisions. In the rare event that you would not able to go home due to anesthesia-related issues or for other unforeseen medical reasons, we will keep you overnight at our partner skilled-nursing facility located adjacent to our surgery center.

Q. Who will be taking care of me at the Central Ohio Urology Surgery Center?

A. In addition to your surgeon, who will consult with you prior to your surgery, you will have an anesthesiologist providing your general anesthesia and a team of nurses and surgical assistants. Our surgeons have performed thousands of robotic surgeries, and we have recruited an outstanding care team who focus solely on urology and robotic surgery.
